

## Community Engagement Supports Power House at Many Levels!

### Examples:

#### Level 1: Awareness

- Attends a community event put on by the coalition.
- Reads a coalition article published in the newspaper.
- Views a social media post made by Power House.

#### Level 2: Interest

- Follows Power House on Facebook or Instagram.
- Signs up for the Power House Newsletter.
- Regularly read Power House emails.

#### Level 3: Participation

- Volunteers at a community event put on by Power House.
- Writes a letter of support for Power House.
- Makes a monetary or other donation to support a Power House Project.
- Supports youth during center activities or special events sometimes.
- Volunteers to paint/cook/ organize or use other talents to support Power House.
- Prays for Power House and its members.

#### Level 4: Commitment

- Speaks at a community event put on by Power House.
- Joins a Power House workgroup/ becomes a regular volunteer with youth OR behind the scenes.
- Serves on the Power House board or joins the Power House Faith Council
- Pays Power House dues regularly/ donates money regularly.
- “Sponsors a teen” each year with a monetary donation.

#### Level 5: Leadership

- Trains individuals in your community to understand and participate in Power House.
- Leads meetings with policy makers and other organizations that focus on a cause Power House cares about.
- Organizes a rally/event in the community for Power House.
